2. Between 2 – 5 minutes in length
3. Topic should be about how “learning is cool”.
4. Podcasts should be of interest to an audience beyond the state of Florida.
5. Teams should consist of a maximum of 2–3 students.

1. Secure a location for your event by **March 31**
2. Arrange provisions for hardware, software, and network access
